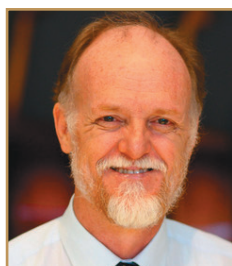
Neil Wickham

CONCERT BAND CONDUCTOR

Neil is a graduate of the Queensland Conservatorium of Music and University of Southern Queensland, has completed Master's degree coursework at Queensland University of Technology and is a member of the Australian Council for Educational Leaders and a Writer Member of the Australian Performing Rights Association.

Ensembles under Neil's direction have won major awards at events including Division 1 of the National Stage Band Awards, the Australian National Band Championships and the Queensland Festival of Music.

He is currently the Principal Woodwind Teacher at Brisbane Grammar School and has been a Woodwind Tutor, Ensemble Director and Audition Panellist for the Queensland Youth Orchestra Council for seventeen years.

SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA CONDUCTOR

A graduate of the Queensland Conservatorium of Music Mark Sullivan has spent four decades actively advocating for the development of quality music programs in schools.

He has completed post-graduate studies in education, and conducting courses with Jerry Nowak, William La Rue Jones and Marvin Rabin.

Mark has worked as a String Teacher and Orchestra Director in over thirty schools in Australia and the USA, where he has created outstanding orchestras, and designed curriculum and policy documents to support emerging programs.

His ensembles have won many prizes at competitions and festivals, and he has toured the USA and Canada with school orchestras.

Mark was awarded the ABODA Outstanding Ensemble Director's Award and the 2010 ASG State and National Inspirational Teaching Award. He was invited to be a guest presenter at the 2012 National Positive Schools Conference where he discussed the impact of music on personal wellbeing.

Mark is committed to enhancing the quality of teacher training and has worked as a part time lecturer at the Queensland Conservatorium of Music, the University of Queensland and the Queensland University of Technology. He also maintains a broad interest in the wider community, founding the Brisbane Regional Youth Orchestra, leading camps and clinics, and adjudicating at festivals and eisteddfodau.

Mark recently retired after a distinguished career as the Director of Instrumental Music at Brisbane Girls Grammar School, to work as a visiting clinician supporting staff and music programs throughout the country.
