Concert Band Guest Conductor Associate Professor Peter Morris

Associate Professor Peter Morris is the Acting Director at the Queensland Conservatorium Griffith University. He is the Head of Ensembles and resident conductor of the Conservatorium Symphony and Wind Orchestras in addition to conducting for Musical Theatre productions and many other exciting projects that arise.

He is responsible for all conducting studies at the Conservatorium, from undergraduate courses to postgraduate and doctoral supervision. Peter is active as a guest conductor and clinician, across Australia and internationally and as a freelance conductor often works for Film and TV recording sessions, in contemporary concert settings and for large-scale cultural productions.

Prior to emigrating to Australia in 2002, Peter performed in the US and internationally on trumpet and as a conductor in a wide variety of genres, from Baroque orchestras to commercial session work in Los Angeles



for film and television. Peter holds a DMA in Conducting from UCLA, and has held university teaching positions in California, Texas and Colorado. Prior to his appointment at QCGU, Peter held the position of Director of Music at Villanova College in Brisbane and retains a strong relationship with schools, teachers and the education sector. He is passionate about professional development in conducting, performance and teaching at all levels of study. He is an advocate for commissioning new works and re-imagining existing musical structures and has an enthusiasm for exploring exciting collaborations to create performances that matter.

Spirit of Fellowship

Symphony Orchestra Conductor

Mr Adrian Head

Over the last three decades Adrian has conducted numerous orchestras & ensembles, nationally & overseas, including the Janacek Philharmonic, the Dohnanyi Symphony, the Sinfonia of St Andrew's, the Ipswich City Symphony, & the Ady Ensemble: a twenty-three piece string orchestra which he founded in 2011, which performs standard repertoire & with newly written commissions & arrangements for the ensemble. In 2016 he studied conducting with Gabor Hollerung in Budapest, Hungary, & in 2017 he travelled to the Czech Republic to study with renowned Finnish conducting pedagogue, Jorma Panula. 2017 also saw Adrian voted a 4MBS Treasured Queensland Classical Musician. Earlier this year he organised & conducted two concerts, helping to provide funds for those affected by last Summer's bushfires.



Adrian has degrees from both the Queensland Conservatorium and the University of Queensland. He was Principal Trombone & Staff Arranger for the Royal Australian Navy, for either years, which also involved a secondment to provide arrangements for the Sydney Olympics & Paralympics. He spent two years in Manchester, working at the Royal Northern College of Music & as a researcher for the Répertoire International des Sources Musicales (RISM).

Choir Conductor

Mr Robert Stewart

Robert Stewart currently serves as Director of Performing Arts at St Joseph's Nudgee College. He is also the conductor of the Conservatorium Singers at Griffith University and the Queensland University Musical Society. Robert was co-founder and conductor of the Exaudi Youth Choir, winners of the Choral Championships at National Eisteddfod. He is frequently engaged as a guest conductor and clinician, working with groups like the ACCET Choral Conductor School, the Festival of Voices, the Pemulwuy National Male Voice Festival, and the Queensland Conservatorium's State Honours Ensemble Program.

Robert is currently completing a Doctor of Musical Arts degree at the Queensland Conservatorium, Griffith University focussing on choral rehearsal processes. He received a Master of Music (Opera) from the Royal Scottish Academy of Music and Drama and is also a graduate of the University of Toronto where he obtained a Bachelor of Music in Performance (Voice) and an Advanced Certificate in Performance. As an undergraduate he also studied orchestral conducting with Dwight Bennett and served as section leader and assistant to Dr. Doreen Rao.



A passionate advocate for boys' music education, Robert has been Director of Music at Melbourne High School—winners of the ABC Flame Award for their innovative music program, including whole-school massed singing. He has also held leadership positions at The Hutchins School and Ormiston College as well as being a lecturer at Monash University and the Victorian College of the Arts.

Big Band Conductor

Bohdan Davison

Bohdan Davison is the current Head of Bands at Anglican Church Grammar School. As part of the role he oversees all of the Wind Symphonies, Big Bands as well as teaching private lessons predominantly for saxophone but also clarinet and bassoon. In his classroom practice he teaches International Baccalaureate Diploma program in the senior years. Bohdan is most appreciative of the opportunities to develop his professional learning at Churchie, working with Essentially Ellington members of the Lincoln Centre Jazz Orchestra and high profile conductors such as Professor Rob McWilliams to provide the best learning opportunities for the music students at Churchie.

Bohdan also holds the position of Queensland Youth Orchestra Big Band Director, which enables him to facilitate and inspire the best secondary and tertiary level students from a range of different backgrounds. His favourite Queensland Youth Orchestra memory to date, was leading a tour to Regional Queensland in December 2020, performing and putting smiles on the faces of rural communities and school students.

As a performer, Bohdan has had the opportunity to tour both Nationally and Internationally with some of the best artists in the world. As a keen Rugby League enthusiast, Bohdan was thrilled to perform live with Pete Murray for the State of Origin at Suncorp Stadium as part of Darren Lockyer's final game in 2011.
